Prayers.

Mr. Coon, Member for Fredericton South, laid upon the table of the House a petition urging the government to reinstate all services and management of Hôtel-Dieu Saint-Joseph de Saint-Quentin. (Petition 15)

Ms. Mitton, Member for Memramcook-Tantramar, laid upon the table of the House a petition urging the government to maintain Murray Beach Provincial Park under provincial control and operation. (Petition 16)

Mr. Arseneault gave Notice of Motion 61 that on Thursday, June 20, 2019, he would move the following resolution, seconded by Mr. Melanson:

THAT an address be presented to Her Honour the Lieutenant-Governor, praying that she cause to be laid upon the table of the House a list of all contracts for professional services, consulting, or similar services, awarded since March 28, 2019, by applying an exemption under the *Procurement Act*, and copies of all personal service contracts entered into by the Office of the Premier and/or the Executive Council Office since March 28, 2019.

Mr. Arseneault gave Notice of Motion 62 that on Thursday, June 20, 2019, he would move the following resolution, seconded by Mr. Melanson:

THAT an address be presented to Her Honour the Lieutenant-Governor, praying that she cause to be laid upon the table of the House a list of all assistant deputy ministers and executive director positions within the government, the current incumbents in each position, and the incumbent in each position as of November 9, 2018.

Mr. Arseneault gave Notice of Motion 63 that on Thursday, June 20, 2019, he would move the following resolution, seconded by Mr. Melanson:

THAT an address be presented to Her Honour the Lieutenant-Governor, praying that she cause to be laid upon the table of the House a list of all appointments made without competition under sections 15 or 16 of the *Civil Service Act* since November 8, 2018.

Mr. Savoie, Government House Leader, announced that it was the intention of government that Bill 39 be called for second reading; following which the House would resolve itself into a Committee of the Whole to consider Bills 35 and 36.

The Order being read for second reading of Bill 39, *An Act Respecting Proof of Immunization*, a debate arose thereon.

And after some time, Mr. C. Chiasson, seconded by Mr. D'Amours, moved in amendment:

AMENDMENT

THAT the motion for second reading be amended by deleting all the words after the word "that" and substituting the following:

Bill 39, *An Act Respecting Proof of Immunization*, be not now read a second time but that the order for second reading be discharged and the subject matter of the Bill referred to the Standing Committee on Law Amendments.

Mr. Speaker put the question on the proposed amendment and a debate ensued.

At 2.48 p.m. the House recessed. At 2.53 p.m. the House resumed.

And the debate being ended, and the question being put, the amendment was resolved in the affirmative.

The House resolved itself into a Committee of the Whole with Ms. LeBlanc in the chair.

At 3.37 p.m. the Committee recessed. At 3.47 p.m. the Committee resumed.

And after some time, Mr. C. Chiasson took the chair.

And after some further time, Mr. Speaker resumed the chair and Mr. C. Chiasson, the Chair, after requesting that Mr. Speaker revert to Presentations of Committee Reports, reported:

That the Committee had directed that he report the following Bill as agreed to:

Bill 35, Cooperatives Act.

And that the Committee had directed that he report the following Bill as amended:

Bill 36, Credit Unions Act.

And the Committee asked leave to make a further report.

Pursuant to Standing Rule 78.1, Mr. Speaker put the question on the motion deemed to be before the House, that the report be concurred in, and it was resolved in the affirmative.
