Message from Lieutenant-Governor

Hon. Mr. Blanchard, Minister of Finance, delivered to Mr. Speaker a Message from Her Honour the Lieutenant-Governor and the said Message was read by Mr. Speaker, all the Members standing, and is as follows:

February 13, 1996.

The Lieutenant-Governor transmits the *Main Estimates* and the *Capital Estimates for the fiscal year ending March 31, 1997*, which include the estimates of the sums required for the services of the Province, not otherwise provided for, for the year ending March 31, 1997, and the *Supplementary estimates 1995-1996* and the *Supplementary Capital Estimates 1995-1996*, and in accordance with the provisions of the *Constitution Act, 867*, recommends these Estimates to the House.
