Mr. Williams rose on a point of order and requested a translated copy of a ministerial statement distributed to Members of the Opposition. Hon Mr. Jamieson, Government House Leader, agreed to provide a translated copy.

Following Oral Question period, Hon. Bill 16, *An Act to Amend the Quarriable Substances Act*.

Ordered that the said Bills be read a second time at the next sitting.

Hon. Mr. Jamieson, Government House Leader, announced that it was the intention of government that following second reading and the time reserved for Private Members' Motions, the House would resume debate on the motion for an Address in Reply to the Speech from the Throne.

The Order being read for second reading of Bill 10, *An Act to Amend the New Brunswick Income Tax Act*, a debate arose thereon.

And after some time, due to the unavoidable absence of Mr. Speaker, Mr. R. Boudreau, the Deputy Speaker, took the chair as Acting Speaker

And after some time, Hon. Mr. Jamieson moved the adjournment of the debate.
