The Honourable the Premier delivered to Mr. Speaker a Message from His Honour the Lieutenant-Governor, and the said Message was read by Mr. Speaker, all the Members standing, and is as follows:

Mr. Speaker and Members of the Legislative Assembly:

I thank you for your Address and beg to assure you that I entertain the fullest confidence that in all your deliberations you will be guided by a most earnest desire to promote the happiness and prosperity of the people of this province.

Hon. Mr. Jamieson, Government House Leader, announced that with the unanimous consent of the House to dispense with the time reserved for Private Members' Motions, it was the intention of government that the House resolve itself into a Committee of the Whole to take into consideration Bills 45, 46, 42 and 3; following which, the House would resolve itself into a Committee of Supply to resume consideration of the Estimates for the Department of Transportation.

It was agreed by unanimous consent to dispense with the two hours reserved for Private Members' motions.

The House resolved itself into a Committee of the Whole with Mr. Kenny in the chair.

And after some time, Mr. B. LeBlanc took the chair as Acting Chairman.

And after some further time, Mr. Kenny resumed the chair.

At 6 o'clock p.m., the Chairman left the chair, to resume again at 7 o'clock p.m.

The Committee resumed with Mr. Kenny in the chair.

And after some time, Mr. B. LeBlanc resumed the chair as Acting Chairman.

At 9.30 o'clock p.m., the Acting Chairman declared a recess and left the chair.

9.54 o'clock p.m.

The Committee resumed with Mr. Kenny in the chair.

And after some time, it was agreed by unanimous consent to continue sitting past the ordinary hour of daily adjournment.

And after some further time, Mr. Speaker resumed the chair and Mr. Kenny, the Chairman, after requesting that Mr. Speaker revert to Presentations of Committee Reports, reported:

That the Committee had directed that he report the following Bills as agreed to:

Bill 45, *An Act to Amend the Family Services Act.*

Bill 46, *An Act To Amend the Intercountry Adoption Act.*

And the Committee asked leave to make a further report.

Pursuant to Standing Rule 78.1, Mr. Speaker put the question on the motion deemed to be before the House, that the report be concurred in, and it was resolved in the affirmative.

And then, 10.15 o'clock p.m., the House adjourned.
