Prayers.

Mr. Steeves, Member for Albert, laid upon the table of the House a petition signed by residents of New Brunswick who oppose Bill 17, *An Act to Amend the Off-Road Vehicle Act.* (Petition 44)

[Petition returned to Member as ruled not to be in compliance with the *Standing Rules* and practices of the House.]

Hon. Mr. Haché, Minister of the Environment, laid upon the table of the House a document entitled *Climate Change Action Plan 2007-2012, Take action! New Brunswick.*

Following Oral Questions, Mr. Speaker cautioned Members against using props, and requested that Members refrain from shouting "time" when other Members are asking or answering questions, and that Members refrain from making personal attacks.

Mr. Huntjens gave Notice of Motion 66 that on Thursday, June 14, 2007, he would move the following resolution, seconded by Mr. Urquhart:

That an address be presented to His Honour the Lieutenant-Governor, praying that he cause to be laid upon the table of the House the following information concerning approved applications for special care homes in the Moncton Region between October 3, 2006, and May 31, 2007: the names of the applicants, the precise locations of the special care homes, and the number of beds in each approved special care home.

Hon. Mr. Jamieson, Government House Leader, announced that following third reading, it was the intention of government that the House resolve itself into a Committee of the Whole to consider Bills 44, 76, 77, 23, 72, 73, 74, and 75.

It was agreed by unanimous consent to vary the hours of sitting and to sit through the noon recess.

The following Bills were read a third time:

Bill 42, *An Act to Repeal the New Brunswick Advisory Council on Seniors Act.*

Bill 81, *Post-Secondary Student Financial Assistance Act.*

Bill 82, *An Act to Amend the Public Health Act.*

Ordered that the said Bills do pass.

The House resolved itself into a Committee of the Whole with Mr. R. Boudreau in the chair.

And after some time, Mr. Kenny took the chair.

And after some time, Mr. Speaker resumed the chair and Mr. Kenny, the Chairman, after requesting that Mr. Speaker revert to Presentations of Committee Reports, reported:

That the Committee had directed that he report the following Bills as agreed to:

Bill 44, *An Act to Amend the Credit Unions Act.*

Bill 72, *An Act Respecting Elections New Brunswick.*

Bill 75, *An Act to Amend the Legislative Assembly Act.*

Bill 76, *An Act to Amend the Community Planning Act.*

Bill 77, *An Act to Amend the Community Planning Act.*

And that the Committee had directed that he report the following Bill as agreed to with certain amendments:

Bill 73, *An Act to Amend the Ombudsman Act.*

Bill 74, *Child and Youth Advocate Act.*

And that the Committee had directed him to report progress on the following Bill:

Bill 23, *An Act to Amend the Members' Conflict of Interest Act.*

And the Committee asked leave to make a further report.

Pursuant to Standing Rule 78.1, Mr. Speaker put the question on the motion deemed to be before the House, that the report be concurred in, and it was resolved in the affirmative.

And then, 3.50 o'clock p.m., the House adjourned.
