Prayers.

Ms. Blaney, Member for Rothesay, laid upon the table of the House a petition in opposition to the practice of “double breasting” and in support of Bill 60, *An Act to Amend the Industrial Relations Act*. (Petition 49)

Hon. Mr. Jamieson, gave Notice of Motion 71 that on Tuesday, July 3, 2007, he would move the following resolution, seconded by Hon. V. Boudreau:

THAT the recommendations contained in the Third Report of the Standing Committee on Procedure presented on May 31, 2006, during the Third Session of the Fifty-fifth Legislature, be concurred in by the House; and

THAT the resulting amendments to the Standing Rules come into effect upon the resumption of the current session of the House, or the commencement of the next session of the House, as the case may be, in the fall 2007, or when the House next meets thereafter.

Hon. Mr. Jamieson, Government House Leader, announced that it was the intention of government that the House resolve itself into a Committee of Supply to resume consideration of the estimates of the Department of Natural Resources, the Department of Education, and the Department of Business New Brunswick.

The House, according to Order, resolved itself into a Committee of Supply with Mr. Kenny in the chair.

And after some time, Mr. B. LeBlanc took the chair.

At 12.30 o'clock p.m., the Chairman left the chair to resume again at 2 o'clock p.m.

2 o'clock p.m.

The Committee resumed with Mr. Kenny in the chair.

And after some time, Mr. B. LeBlanc resumed the chair.

At 2.42 o'clock p.m., the Chairman declared a recess and left the chair.

2.49 o'clock p.m.

The Committee resumed with Mr. B. LeBlanc in the chair.

And after some time, Mr. Kenny resumed the chair.

And after some further time, Mr. Speaker resumed the chair, and Mr. Kenny, the Chairman, after requesting that Mr. Speaker revert to Presentations of Committee Reports, reported that the Committee had had under consideration the matters referred to them, had made some progress therein, and asked leave to sit again.

Pursuant to Standing Rule 78.1, Mr. Speaker then put the question on the motion deemed to be before the House, that the report be concurred in, and it was resolved in the affirmative.

And then 6 o'clock p.m. the House adjourned.
