Mr. Steeves, Member for Albert, laid upon the table of the House a petition on behalf of residents of Gunningsville and Lower Coverdale urging the government to establish an action plan for the construction of a new Riverview East K-8 school. (Petition 36)

Hon. Mr. Murphy, Government House Leader, announced that it was the intention of the government to proceed with second reading of Bills 56, 57, 59, 63, 66, 69, 70, 71, 72, 74 and 78.

Hon. Mr. Murphy further announced that it was the intention of government to call Bill 82 for second reading on Wednesday, June 11, 2008.

The Order being read for second reading of Bill 56, *An Act to Amend the Credit Unions Act*, a debate arose thereon.

And after some time, due to the unavoidable absence of Mr. Speaker, Mr. Fraser, the Deputy Speaker, took the chair as Acting Speaker.

And the debate being ended, and the question being put that Bill 56 be now read a second time, it was resolved in the affirmative.

Accordingly, Bill 56, An Act to Amend the Credit Unions Act, was read a second time.

The Order being read for second reading of Bill 57, *An Act to Amend the Motor Vehicle Act*, a debate arose thereon.

And the debate being ended, and the question being put that Bill 57 be now read a second time, it was resolved in the affirmative.

Accordingly, Bill 57, An Act to Amend the Motor Vehicle Act, was read a second time.

The Order being read for second reading of Bill 59, *An Act to Amend the Municipalities Act*, a debate arose thereon.

And the debate being ended, and the question being put that Bill 59 be now read a second time, it was resolved in the affirmative.

Accordingly, Bill 59, An Act to Amend the Municipalities Act, was read a second time.

The Order being read for second reading of Bill 63, An Act to Amend the Residential Property Tax Relief Act, a debate arose thereon.

And the debate being ended, and the question being put that Bill 63 be now read a second time, it was resolved in the affirmative.

Accordingly, Bill 63, An Act to Amend the Residential Property Tax Relief Act, was read a second time.

The Order being read for second reading of Bill 66, *Gaming Control Act*, a debate arose thereon.

And after some time, Mr. Kenny, the Deputy Speaker, took the chair as Acting Speaker.

And after some further time, Mr. Fraser took the chair as Acting Speaker.

And the debate continuing, Mr. Kenny took the chair.

And the debate being ended, and the question being put that Bill 66 be now read a second time, it was resolved in the affirmative.

Accordingly, Bill 66, Gaming Control Act, was read a second time.

The Order being read for second reading of Bill 69, *Gift Cards Act*, a debate arose thereon.

And after some time, Mr. Deputy Speaker interrupted proceedings and announced that the time of daily adjournment had arrived.

And then, 6 o'clock p.m., the House adjourned.
