Mr. Speaker reminded Members that the 20th Annual Student Legislative Seminar to be held in the Chamber over the next several days.

Mr. Holder, Member for Saint John Portland, laid upon the table of the House a petition on behalf of concerned citizens opposed to the removal of regional government services and jobs in rural New Brunswick, including jobs from the Cap-Pelé Government Garage and the ferries in the lower St. John River. (Petition 48)

Ms. Blaney, Member for Rothesay, laid upon the table of the House a petition on behalf of residents of the Rothesay area urging the government to make the required capital investments in Kennebecasis Park Elementary School. (Petition 49)

Hon. Mr. Murphy, Government House Leader, announced that it was the intention of government that the House resolve itself into a Committee of Supply to consider the estimates of the Department of Public Safety and the Department of Transportation.

Hon. Mr. Murphy gave notice that on Tuesday, April 28, 2009, Bill 49 would be called for second reading.

It was agreed by unanimous consent to continue sitting through the noon recess and to adjourn no later than 3.30 o'clock p.m.

The House, according to order, resolved itself into a Committee of Supply with Mr. Fraser in the chair.

And after some time, Mr. Holder rose on a point of order and requested that Hon. Mr. Foran withdraw the term "lazy" in reference to the Opposition. The Member withdrew the remark.

At 12.34 o'clock p.m., the chairman declared a recess and left the chair.

The Committee resumed with Mr. Fraser in the chair.

And after some time, Ms. Robichaud took the chair.

And after some further time, Mr. Fraser resumed the chair.

And after some further time spent in Committee of Supply, Mr. Speaker resumed the chair, and Mr. Fraser, the Chairman,

after requesting that Mr. Speaker revert to Presentations of Committee Reports, reported that the Committee had had under consideration the matters referred to them, had made some progress therein, and asked leave to sit again.

Pursuant to Standing Rule 78.1, Mr. Speaker then put the question on the motion deemed to be before the House, that the report be concurred in, and it was resolved in the affirmative.

And then 3.30 o'clock p.m. the House adjourned.
