Due to the unavoidable absence of Mr. Speaker, Mr. Fraser, the Deputy Speaker, took the chair as Acting Speaker.

Mr. Steeves, Member for Albert, laid upon the table of the House a petition on behalf of residents of the Riverview and Lower Coverdale areas urging the government to allocate funds toward a new K-8 school in the east end of Riverview to replace the Gunningsville Elementary and Lower Coverdale Schools. (Petition 52)

Hon. Mr. Murphy, Government House Leader, announced that it was the intention of government that the House resolve itself into a Committee of Supply to consider the estimates of the Advisory Council on the Status of Women and the Department of Social Development.

The House, according to Order, resolved itself into a Committee of Supply with Ms. Robichaud in the chair.

And after some time, Mr. Fraser, the Deputy Speaker resumed the chair, and Ms. Robichaud, the Chair, after requesting that Mr. Deputy Speaker revert to Presentations of Committee Reports, reported that the Committee had had under consideration the matters referred to them, had made some progress therein, had passed several items, and asked leave to sit again.

Pursuant to Standing Rule 78.1, Mr. Deputy Speaker then put the question on the motion deemed to be before the House, that the report be concurred in, and it was resolved in the affirmative.
