Prayers.

Mr. Urquhart, Member for York, laid upon the table of the House a petition on behalf of residents of Hanwell, McAdam, Tweedside, Harvey, Harvey Station, Mazerolle Settlement Road, Prince William and surrounding areas who oppose the sale of NB Power to Hydro-Québec. (Petition 216)

Mr. C. LeBlanc, Member for Dieppe Centre-Lewisville, laid upon the table of the House a petition on behalf of residents of Miramichi, Newcastle, Bathurst and surrounding areas who oppose the sale of NB Power to Hydro-Québec. (Petition 217)

Following Oral Questions, Mr. Robichaud rose on a point of order and submitted that Hon. S. Graham had referred to a Member by name and not by constituency. Mr. Speaker ruled the point well taken.

The following Bill was introduced and read a first time.

Bill 43, *An Act to Amend the Insurance Act*.

Mr. Williams gave Notice of Motion 45 that on Tuesday, March 2, 2010, he would move the following resolution, seconded by Mr. C. Landry:

That an address be presented to His Honour the Lieutenant-Governor, praying that he cause to be laid upon the table of the House all information in government possession, however recorded or stored, regarding any contracts, agreements, or commitments between the government and the Shippagan Marine Service Centre, the Bas-Caraquet Marine Service Centre, and the Fundy Marine Service Centre.

Mr. C. Landry gave Notice of Motion 46 that on Tuesday, March 2, 2010, he would move the following resolution, seconded by Ms. Dubé:

That an address be presented to His Honour the Lieutenant-Governor, praying that he cause to be laid upon the table of the House a list of all projects that received funding from the Northern New Brunswick Infrastructure Initiative in the fiscal year beginning April 1, 2008, with the names of the recipient companies or organizations, the places or localities where the projects are being developed, and the amount awarded to each project.

Pursuant to Standing Rule 44(4), Mr. Robichaud, Opposition House Leader, gave notice that on Thursday, February 25, 2010, Opposition Members' Business would be considered in the following order: Motion 44; resumption of the debate on Motions 41 and 29; and resumption of the debate on the motion for second reading of Bill 24.

Hon. Mr. Byrne, Government House Leader, announced that it was the intention of government that the House resolve itself into a Committee of Supply to consider the estimates of the Department of Finance, the Department of Natural Resources and the Department of Health.

Hon. Mr. Byrne gave notice that on Friday, February 26, Bills 34, 35, 36, 37, 38 and 39 would be called for second reading.

The House, according to Order, resolved itself into a Committee of Supply with Ms. Robichaud in the chair.

At 12.30 o'clock p.m., Ms. Robichaud left the chair to resume again at 2 o'clock p.m.

The Committee resumed with Ms. Robichaud in the chair.

At 4.31 o'clock p.m., Ms. Robichaud declared a recess and left the chair.

4.37 o'clock p.m.

The Committee resumed with Ms. Robichaud in the chair.

And after some time, Mr. Speaker resumed the chair, and Ms. Robichaud, the Chair, after requesting that Mr. Speaker revert to Presentations of Committee Reports, reported that the Committee had had under consideration the matters referred to them, had made some progress therein, and asked leave to sit again.

Pursuant to Standing Rule 78.1, Mr. Speaker then put the question on the motion deemed to be before the House, that the report be concurred in, and it was resolved in the affirmative.

And then, 6 o'clock p.m., the House adjourned.
