Message From the Muncipal Electoral Officer

Report on the 2023 Local Government By-Elections

I am pleased to present the report on the local government by elections held in various communities throughout the province in February and October 2023.

The report includes information on the following events:

February 13, 2023

An Act Respecting Local Governance Reform, 2022, no. 2, S.N.B. 2022, c.56, received Royal Assent on December 16, 2022. Among other provisions, it changed the number of councillors to elect in Wards 2 and 3 of Valley Waters and required the Municipal Electoral Officer to hold a by-election to fill the newly created vacancy in Ward 2 on February 13, 2023. Given the fact a by-election was now scheduled, the Municipal Electoral Officer decided to also hold a by-election to fill a council vacancy in Ward 3, which was left empty following the election that was held in November 2022.

Polls were held to fill the vacancies. Following the close of nominations, 1,824 electors were eligible to vote in contested elections. Of these, 183 electors cast ballots, equalling a participation rate of 10.03%.

The direct cost for these by-elections was approximately \$59,593.

October 23, 2023

By-elections were scheduled for October 23, 2023, to fill 19 vacancies on 12 local government councils.

At the close of nominations on September 29, 2023, there were a sufficient number of candidates to hold elections in the following local governments:

- Beaurivage (Councillor at large, Councillor Ward 6);
- Fredericton Junction (Mayor);
- Grand Lake (Councillor Ward 4);
- Grand Manan (2 councillors at large);
- Hanwell (Councillor at large, Councillor Ward 4);
- Neguac (Councillor at large);
- Riverview (Councillor at large);
- Southern Victoria (Councillor, Ward 2);
- Sunbury-York South (Councillor, Ward 1); and
- Tracy (2 Councillors at large).

Candidates were elected by acclamation in the following local governments:

- Beaurivage (Councillor Ward 2);
- Hanwell (Councillor, Ward 5); and
- Upper Miramichi (Councillor Ward 1, Councillor Ward 3).



A candidate running for the vacancy in Grand Manan subsequently withdrew after the close of nominations, creating two additional acclamations.

One council vacancy for Campobello Island remained vacant following the close of nominations.

Polls were held to fill all remaining vacancies, with a total of 31,802 eligible electors for all contests province-wide.

Overall voter turnout ranged from a low of 8.27% for the council position in Sunbury-York South, to a high of 53.97% in Grand Lake.

Recount

The contest in Beaurivage, Ward 6, ended with a one vote difference between the winner and the individual who placed second. A recount requested by the runner-up did not result in a change from the results that were reported on election night.

The direct cost for these by-elections was approximately \$527,706.
